## Cleaning specifications



Water washing: Operation to clean textile products in a water bath. The washing treatment includes all or some of the following operations, duly combined:

- Wetting, pre-wash and main wash - generally using hot water, using mechanical cleaning with detergents or other products - and rinsing;
- Water extraction, obtained by centrifugation or wringing, during and / or at the end of the previous operations.

Water wash: the lining can be washed at the maximum temperature indicated in the symbol $\left(30^{\circ}-40^{\circ}-60^{\circ}\right)$.

Water wash: the lining can be washed with a gentle cycle indicated in the symbol $\left(30^{\circ}-40^{\circ}-60^{\circ}\right)$.


Chlorine bleaching: performed in a water bath before, during or after washing with the use of a chlorine based product designed to remove stains and/or improve whiteness.

Chlorine bleaching: this symbol indicates that it is NOT possible to treat the lining with bleach or chlorine.


Ironing: operation performed on a textile product in order to restore the original shape and appearance by means of appropriate equipment using heat and pressure.

Dry cleaning: operation designed to clean textile products using organic solvents.
This treatment includes cleaning, rinsing, spinning and drying.

Drying by means of a rotary drum dryer: a process performed on a textile product after washing and designed to remove residual water by means of air.

Drying by means of a tumble-dryer: NOT possible.

Horizontal drying outdoors without wringing or spinning.

Vertical drying outdoors without wringing or spinning.
